## **Thrive Renewables plc**

### **Investment Analyst, Clean Energy Infrastructure - Full time, permanent appointment**

An opportunity to join an established and growing sustainable energy business. Thrive Renewables plc acquires, builds and operates sustainable energy projects. We currently own and operate 16 wind farms and a hydro-electric project and are invested in 4 other renewable energy projects. Thrive operates a renewable energy portfolio of 104MW with an asset value of £85m and annual turnover of £15m. We are funded by investment from 6,200 investors who are motivated by achieving financial, environmental and social returns.

This role complements the existing investment and finance teams which have responsibility for origination and structuring new investments and the commercial and financial management of our portfolio of renewable projects. As part of a small multi-disciplined executive team the position is pivotal in informing strategy and contributing to the investment modelling, transaction structuring, project financing and commercial operation of the group of companies.

We are looking for an Investment Analyst with a suitable finance or business qualification, at least four years' experience and the capacity to proactively contribute to the investment management process and growth and optimisation of Thrive Renewables' business. The ideal candidate will have strong financial modelling skills, familiarity with working in a multi-company (group) environment and infrastructure investments. Experience of renewables or the energy sector is also desirable. The role requires a proactive approach and the ability to contribute to a small, well motivated team.

### **Responsibilities include**

- Providing financial modelling and analysis at both asset and portfolio level;
- Providing analysis to support acquisition evaluation and structuring process, analysing potential transactions and investments including economic benefits and risks;
- Supporting the commercial management of investments (acquisitions, subordinated debt, joint ventures, VC investments);
- Input collation, research and information gathering from a variety of sources including clients, asset managers, contractors, due diligence reports and public sources;
- Managing the relationships and reporting with debt providers including covenant testing;
- Monitoring and contributing to the performance of joint ventures and investee companies;
- Supporting the budgeting process and performing cost and revenue analysis;
- Monitoring and performing analysis of changes in the operational environment to inform risk management, operations and deal structuring;
- Delivering analysis of commercial impact of contracts;
- Monitoring and reporting of risks;
- Managing ad hoc analysis and projects.
