Thrive has to date invested in a renewable energy portfolio of 104MW with an asset value over £100m and annual turnover of £15m.

This role complements the existing investment and finance teams which have responsibility for origination and structuring of new investments and the commercial and financial management of our portfolio of renewable projects. As part of a small multi-disciplined executive team, the position is pivotal in informing strategy and contributing to the investment modelling, transaction structuring, project financing and commercial operation of the group of companies.

We are looking for an Investment Analyst with a suitable finance or business qualification, at least four years' experience and the capacity to proactively contribute to the investment management process and growth and optimisation of the commercial operations of Thrive Renewables' business. The ideal candidate will have strong financial modelling skills, an interest in sustainable energy/infrastructure and a thirst to learn and contribute. Experience of renewables and analysis of multiple technologies (solar, battery storage, wind, hydro) or the energy sector is also desirable. The role requires a proactive approach and the ability to contribute to a small, well motivated team.

Responsibilities include

- Delivering financial modelling and analysis at both asset and portfolio level;
- Delivering analysis to support acquisition evaluation and structuring process, analysing potential transactions and investments;
- Optimisation and modelling of multiple revenue streams from varied renewable generation assets;
- Supporting the commercial management of investments (acquisitions, subordinated debt, joint ventures);
- Input collation, research and information gathering from a variety of sources including clients, asset managers, contractors, due diligence reports and public sources;
- Assist with Board and senior lenders reporting;

- Monitoring and contributing to the performance of joint ventures and investee companies;
- Supporting the budgeting process and performing cost and revenue analysis;
- Supporting the asset management of the new operational investments and delivering analysis of commercial impact on contracts;
- Managing ad hoc analysis and projects.
